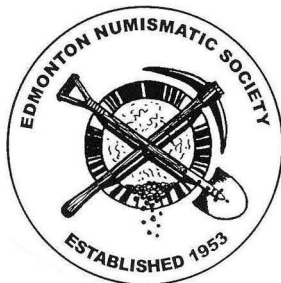

The Edmonton Numismatic Society



The Edmonton Numismatic Society (ENS) dates back to September 1953. At that time the members met and discussed the hobby under the name, the Edmonton Coin Club. During the 1960's, 70's, and 80's the Club sponsored 20 Annual Coin-A-Rama shows, issuing many collectible souvenirs.

In 1979, The City of Edmonton's 75th Anniversary, the Club was host to its first CNA Convention. A number of mini shows and Anniversary shows were held during the 1980's and 90's. As a reflection of the varied collecting interest of the current membership, and a continuing commitment to promote the hobby, the Club changed its name to the Edmonton Numismatic Society just prior to hosting its second CNA Convention in 1998. Since 1996 the Club has sponsored two shows each year, one in the late winter/early spring and one in the fall.

He informed the membership that the current room would no longer be available for meetings after April 2007 as the museum will be undergoing major renovations for approximately the next two years. The executive will be attempting to locate and secure a new meeting location. Suggestions from members would be appreciated.

Member from Calgary, *James Williston* was introduced and offered congratulations from the ENS to the Calgary Numismatic Society for their recent naming as CNA Coin Club of the Year at the 2006 Convention Banquet held in Niagara Falls in July.

A number of books from the club library as well as some up-coming auction catalogues (Heritage Numismatics and C&P) were available for member viewing.

The evening's presentation was conducted by ENS Past President *Dan Gosling*. Dan's talk and photo slide show was about the Canadian Numismatic Society 2006 Convention in Niagara Falls and the 2006 American Numismatic Association 2006 Convention "World's Fair of Money" in Denver, Colorado.

Dan is currently CNA 2nd Vice-President as well as the CNA Librarian /Archivist and Associate Editor/Web Master.

Dan's presentation and commentary included executive and various dignitaries, opening ceremonies, guest speakers, exhibit winners, exhibit judges, attendees at numerous meetings, and award winners as well as candid shots on the bourse floor of dealers and customers.

March 2006 Show Report

Thanks to the support of the public and dealers, the ENS November show was once again a success. The following is a summary of attendance at the Show:

- Pre-sales attending Saturday – 120;
- Paid attendance Saturday – 169;
- Free Junior attendance Saturday – 33;
- Dealers in attendance Saturday – 52;
- Pre-sales attending Sunday – 52;
- Total Attendance for both days – 638.

Our numbers were up from the March 2005 Show. Dealer sales by most accounts were up, with some dealers having their best show ever!

EDMONTON NUMISMATIC SOCIETY NOVEMBER 11 & 12, 2006 MONEY SHOW UPDATE

Alberta's economy is booming right now, and like everything else, our costs are going up. At time of this writing, our executive has announced an increase in the case rentals from \$5 each to \$10 each, for the 2 day show. Lamp rental will remain at \$3 each. We have been replacing our current cases with Allstate cases, and this will help us do this over the next few years. NOTE: dealers will be unable to set up Friday night due to a function in the Imperial Ballroom lasting till midnight. Setup for dealers will be between 7:00am to 10:00am Saturday only.

We continue to look for more opportunities to promote the show and can advise we have several other collector related publications where our show will be promoted. As usual, in an effort to attract out of town collectors, we will be advertising in area papers, as well as radio and Free TV stations. All local shops will have posters, as well as the Libraries and City Hall. Members have been selling Admission/Draw tickets since September. Paid advertising will be placed in local papers the week prior to and the week of the show. We also hope to once again obtain significant free advertising in the Edmonton Journal Community Events. In addition, the Hotel also has an electronic billboard which will advertise the show. We will once again have an ad in Canadian Coin News just before the show. All this worked very well for our previous shows.

Additional promotion is being provided by Stan Wright, as he will be holding his 5th Auction on Saturday night in conjunction with our show. This has brought considerable interest to the last show and we expect the same for the November show.
