The Edmonton Numismatic Society (ENS) dates back to September 1953. At that time the members met and discussed the hobby under the name, the Edmonton Coin Club. During the 1960's, 70's, and 80's the Club sponsored 20 Annual Coin-A-Rama shows, issuing many collectible souvenirs.

In 1979, The City of Edmonton's 75th Anniversary, the Club was host to its first CNA Convention. A number of mini shows and Anniversary shows were held during the 1980's and 90's. As a reflection of the varied collecting interest of the current membership, and a continuing commitment to promote the hobby, the Club changed its name to the Edmonton Numismatic Society just prior to hosting its second CNA Convention in 1998. Since 1996 the Club has sponsored two shows each year, one in the late winter/early spring and one in the fall.

Canadian mule coins

Here is a complete list of Canadian mule coins minted by the RCM. These coins were more than likely minted accidentally with a wrong combination of dies. The New Zealand mules are omitted from Charlton and this list since the obverse dictates what country a coin is from.

- 1¢ 1949 with 1948 obverse: “A” to denticle
- 1¢ 1954 with 1953 obverse: no shoulder fold (proof like)
- 1¢ 1955 with 1953 obverse: no shoulder fold
- 1¢ 1965 with large beads, pointed 5 (Type 4)
- 5¢ 1951 with beaver reverse, high relief obverse
- 5¢ 1953 with: no shoulder fold (early 1953 obverse), near leaf (late 1953 reverse)
- 5¢ 1953 with: shoulder fold (late 1953 obverse), far leaf (early 1953 reverse)
- 10¢ 1871H with 1872H NFDL obverse
- 25¢ 1952 with 1951 obverse: high relief
- 25¢ 1973 with 1972 obverse: “large bust”
- 25¢ 1993 with 1992 obverse (proof like)
- 25¢ 1999 September reverse, Token obverse
- 25¢ 1999 November reverse, Token obverse
- 25¢ 2000 Map Token reverse, coin obverse
- 50¢ 1953 with large date, no shoulder fold
- 50¢ 1982 with 1983 obverse: type 2, small beads
- \$1 1966 with 1965 obverse: small beads
- \$2 1999 Nunavut with “no rim” reverse (proof die)
- \$10 1973 Olympic map coin with 1974 dated obverse

December Meeting

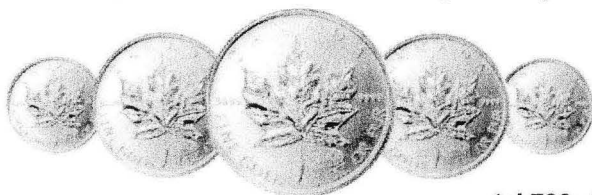

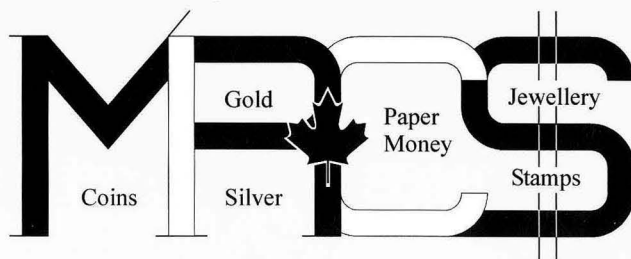

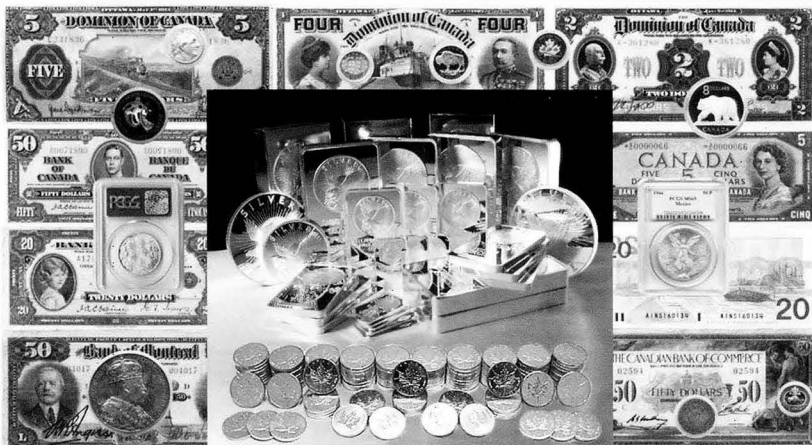
